2012 NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

These races will be governed by the rules, as defined by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). One-design class rules shall apply. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions govern.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising shall be limited to Class A, unless otherwise directed by class rules or a class's Olympic status.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Classes given starts will be Stars, Ensigns, and any other class of three or more boats by prior arrangement with the race committee.
- 3.2 Contestants shall register with their respective class fleets, which shall set and collect all fees.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The first warning signal each day will be made at 0930 hrs. The order of starts for the first race of the day is Class I (Stars), Class II (Ensigns), and Class III (any other classes). Start sequences will not be given for absent classes; class numbers shall be maintained for purposes of course posting.
- 4.2 If the race committee intends to start another race for a class, it will display code flag R (with no sound) and the class flags(s) of the class(es) having another race, while boats are finishing.
- 4.3 The scheduled race committee for each Sunday is indicated below; Tri Club race RCs will be furnished by the Ensign fleet.

May 27 – Centerport 2	July 8 – Centerport 2	August 19 –Northport 2
June 3 – Northport 2	July 15 – Centerport 2	August 26 – Northport 2
June 10 – Ensign Flt 3	July 22 – Northport 2	September 2 – Centerport 2
June 17 – Ensign Flt 1	July 29 – Centerport 2	September 9 - Ensign Flt 3
June 24 – Northport 2	August 5 - Centerport 2	September 16 – Ensign Flt 2

- 4.4 Normally there will be one long race for Stars; they will sail two races on regatta dates.
- 4.5 The number of races planned for Ensigns each day is indicated as above.
- 4.6 Memorial Day Regatta – May 27 & June 3; Independence Day Regatta – July 1 & 8; Labor Day Regatta – August 26 and September 2.
- 4.7 Single-handed Series - June 10; Iron Man – Aug. 12; Two-handed Series Sept. 9 & 16, alternate date 23.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at www.centerport-yc.org and from the race committee.

6. COURSES

The courses will be set in Northport and Huntington Bays and will be described fully in the sailing instructions.

7. PROTESTS

The protest procedure will be described in the sailing instructions. The persons who shall be notified and with whom written protests or requests for redress shall be filed are:

Prizes will be awarded by the class fleets.
